



APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY RESIDENCE PERMITS CHECKLIST FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students admitted to the University of St. Martin as **full time degree seeking students** are eligible for temporary residence permit status. The following information must be provided to the University of St. Martin in order for requests to be submitted to Immigration & Naturalization Services (INS).

Students must provide the following:

- Acceptance letter from the University of St. Martin
- Declaration of Guarantor completely filled in by USM
- Model I completely filled out and signed by applicant, accompanied by a NAF 545,- / US\$307.95 Adult First-Time Application & Guarantor Fee.
- Affidavit of financial ability to pay for his/her program of study from his/her bank or financial institution and proof of sufficient means of existence of at least Naf 1000.- per month
- Declaration supporting the agreement made with the Bank authorizing monthly transactions
- Two recent passport pictures
- Crib number (collected from the Tax office)
- A copy of the valid passport (**all pages, color scan/copy of identification page**)
- Police Clearance (**not older than 3 months**)
- A birth certificate (**must be legalized by apostille stamp, not older than 1 year**)
- A Certificate of marriage or non-marriage (**must be legalized by apostille stamp, not older than 6 months**)
- Medical insurance coverage
- A medical declaration (certificate of good health)
- A valid return ticket to your country of origin
- Tuition Deposit US\$500.00 (certified bank check made payable to **University of St. Martin**)

Students will only be admitted to Sint Maarten for the duration of his/her program of study. The student, on request of the immigration authorities, must produce a permit.
