

PART-TIME FACULTY :LITERATURE (ENG 231 & ENG 243)

The University of St. Martin is seeking an enthusiastic and knowledgeable Literature Instructor to teach two courses in the upcoming Fall Semester: Elements of Literature (ENG 231) and Caribbean Literature (ENG 243). Both courses introduce students to key literary concepts through poetry, prose, and critical analysis, with a strong emphasis on Caribbean voices and cultural context.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

ENG 231 – Elements of Literature (3 credits):

This course is dedicated to introducing students to the basic elements of literature. The course provides for the evaluation of a wide range of literature in the form of the short story and other texts and explores the cultural and social context. Also, by studying various kinds of verse, including Caribbean

poetry, students will be introduced to the fundamentals of poetics and their use in interpreting and evaluating literature in general. **Prerequisite: ENG 112**

ENG 243 – Caribbean Literature (4 credits):

This course introduces students to Caribbean literary traditions, covering oral storytelling, poetry, fiction, and critical essays. Students will explore representative works by Caribbean authors and engage in literary interpretation from both historical and cultural perspectives.

Prerequisite: ENG 112

- Demonstrated experience teaching literature at the college level
- Strong familiarity with Caribbean literary traditions
- Passion for literary analysis and student engagement
