    - B. Original High school transcripts (must be sealed and stamped)
  - C. Exam results (CXC /HAVO /BAC/GED results (if applicable))
  - D. Personal Essay (see application package)
  - E. Two (2) passport pictures
  - F. Copy of passport (Verified at USM)
  - G. Proof of Residency/ Registration form
  - J. Affidavit of financial support (see application package)
- 3. Submit your application before the deadline
- Meet all USM's acceptance criteria (Additional requirements not listed here may be necessary for admittance to this program.)
- 5. Sit the Placement Exams
- 6. Attend Student Orientation
- 7. Meet with your Division Heads/Coordinator before registering for classes
- 8. Start your classes!
- 9. International Students should apply a semester prior to the date of desired enrollment.
