About the Program The goal of the ESL program is to help ESL students achieve a balance of language that would allow them to perform competently – and on par with their native peers, in the world of work, and in advanced programs at USM or other English colleges and universities.

ESL Basic and Level 1 courses are 72-hour programs. Each class is held 3x a week for 2 hours over a period of 12 weeks. The program encourages students, through an immersion process, to learn the language through different methods, such as using a translator app on their cell phones, to be understood.

Level 1 (Pre-intermediate)	\$615
Level 2 (Intermediate)	\$590
Level 3 (Upper-intermediate)	\$590
Level 4 (Advanced)	\$565

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. Complete your USM Application form
 - a. \$25 application fee
2. Submit Supporting Documents:
 - a. Two (2) passport pictures
 - b. Copy of passport (Verified at USM)
3. A date will then be set to do a placement test.
4. You're then placed in the appropriate level.
5. Start your classes!
6. All tuition and fees MUST be paid in full by the end of the 2nd month of classes.
